**The Healthy Homes Program and Lead Hazard Control Program**

Homes built prior to 1978 may have hidden lead-based paint hazards, which can put entire families and especially small children at risk for lead poisoning. The Erie County Health Department has been awarded \$1.5 million to help render these homes as "lead-safe". They have also been awarded \$150 thousand to their Healthy Homes program, which can be used to eliminate other health and safety hazards in homes. Learn more about the risks, how to protect your family, and if you qualify for this local grant opportunity.
