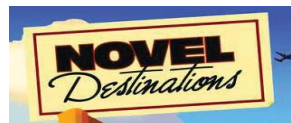
Join us for a special game day where we will play a variety of games that will take us around the world! Board games, the Wii, charades, and more will be a part of this exciting journey.
